ACS Goods Description Quick Reference Guide

Why a detailed Goods Description?

Globally, a compliant goods description is essential for efficient and timely processing of your shipment. Shipments with vague goods descriptions, such as 'samples', 'parts', can and will be held by customs. EU Customs mandates accurate, precise and nongeneric goods descriptions as they need to be able to derive the 6-digit HS code from it - this is on line-item basis if shipment Export, transit or is destined EU.

Advice on how to create a specific & non generic goods description.

Remember to ask yourself following questions when detailing the goods description:

- 1. What are the goods?
- 2. What are they used for or who will use them?

For EU specific, to be able to derive the 6-digt HS code also ask the question:

3. What are they made of? Steel, Cotton, Plastic...
